- Mrs Stevens shared that Miss Murphy is running a baking club in spring term. Discussions are underway about it being for KS2 and younger children. Lyla and Aurelio said they thought that year 6 would be really interested – as preparation for Cookery lessons in year 7.
- Y6 boys feel their toilet area is not kept clean, dry and tidy and this could be due to the fact that children in other year groups use it during break times. Mrs Stevens said that we would like to have new loos for year 6 and this would be prioritised once the well being hub was organised.
