

Pupil Parliament Anti-Bullying Report

What we've been up2

- We took part in UK Anti-Bullying Week 2020. We joined in with Odd Socks Day and our Pupil Parliament Anti-Bullying Ministers planned and led the assembly. We took part in Andy and The Odd Socks' competition to design the CD cover. Children in Key Stage 1 also entered a draw to be part of the writing process for Andy and The Odd Socks' single in the Summer Term. Classes also took part in workshops and completed cross-curricular work, including writing Anti-Bullying poetry.
- Pupils across the school completed a wellbeing questionnaire that included a section of questions involving their feelings towards anti-bullying in our school. These results have been used to inform teachers and support the Pupil Parliament in prioritising wellbeing, prompting us to introduce mindfulness strategies across school where the school voted for Yoga Videos to be created and published by the Pupil Parliament.
- We regularly keep active in the classroom and in assemblies with Super Movers and the Super Mood Movers has become one of our favourite videos which teaches us about rights and respect.

Coming Up

- Selected pupils will be taking part in Anti-Bullying ambassadors training to earn their Diana Awards (March).
- Continuing to prioritise wellbeing with further initiatives such as: Mindfulness Colouring Club; and creating a Reflection Area.
