Children could have the egg resemble someone who has inspired them, create a scene incorporating the egg, make a quotation egg....etc.

Before you do this you should either hard-boil your egg first or you could remove the inside of the egg and leave an empty shell. A quick internet search will tell you how to do this. **NO UNCOOKED EGGS PLEASE!**

Bring the eggs in to school on **Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> April or Wednesday 2 April** and each class will create their Egg-citing display ready for judging.

There will be a prize for the winning entry in each class.
