### CODE OF CONDUCT

#### 1. Purpose and scope

At Archbishop Cranmer we believe it's important to:

- Work in partnership with parents and carers to support their child's learning
- Create a safe, respectful and inclusive environment for pupils, staff, parents and carers
- Model appropriate behaviour for our pupils at all times

To help us do this, we set clear expectations and guidelines on behaviour for all members of our community. This includes staff (through the staff code of conduct) and pupils (through our behaviour policy).

This code of conduct aims to help the school work together with parents and carers by setting guidelines on appropriate behaviour.

#### 2. Our expectations of parents and carers

We expect parents, carers and other visitors to:

- Respect the ethos, vision and values of our school
- Work together with staff in the best interests of our pupils
- Treat all members of the school community with respect – setting a good example with speech and behaviour
- Seek a peaceful solution to all issues
- Correct their own child's behaviour (or those in their care), particularly in public, where it could lead to conflict, aggression or unsafe conduct
- Approach the right member of school staff to help resolve any issues of concern

### 3. Behaviour that will not be tolerated

- Disrupting, or threatening to disrupt, school operations (including events on the school grounds and sports team matches)
- Swearing or using offensive language
- Displaying a temper or shouting at members of staff, pupils or other parents / carers
- Threatening another members of the school community
- Sending abusive messages to another member of the school community, including via text, email or social media
- Posting defamatory, offensive or derogatory comments about the school, its staff or any member of its community, on social media platforms
- Use of physical punishment against your child while on school premises
- Any aggressive behaviour (including verbally or in writing) towards another child or adult
- Disciplining another person's child – please bring any behaviour incidents to a member of staff's attention
- Smoking or drinking alcohol on the school premises (unless alcohol has been allowed at a specific event)
- Possessing or taking drugs (including legal highs)
- Bringing dogs onto the school premises (other than guide dogs)

### 4. Breaching the code of conduct

If the school suspects, or becomes aware, that a parent or carer has breached the code of conduct, the school will gather information from those involved and speak to the parent or carer about the incident.

Depending on the nature of the incident, the school may then:

- Send a warning letter to the parent or carer
- Invite the parent or carer in to school to meet with a senior member of staff or the Head teacher
