The Foundation, Year 1, 2 and 3 pupils took part in a day with a key focus on reducing gender stereotypes. Framed in a positive and constructive way, the activities encouraged children not to rule out career options for themselves because of their gender.

Year 2 and 3 pupils also went on a rail careers journey using the construction of a track with K'nex to explore challenges and careers along the way.

Year 4 pupils learnt about robots and their importance in the modern world whilst working in teams to code robots to complete fun challenges.

All the activities involved our pupils taking part in question and answer sessions with a range of career volunteers from the world of work who visited our school to inspire our children and share an insight into the jobs they do.
